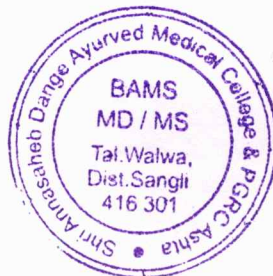
**Objectives of event / activity:-**

# Tamil Nadu Agricultural University kickstarts the International year of millets 2023 with four new varieties of millets

The university has also developed new tree varieties to support the afforestation programme of the state government

Four new varieties of millets have been introduced by the Tamil Nadu Agricultural University (TNAU) to commemorate the International year of Millets 2023. The TNAU has also introduced 23 varieties of new crops. The four new millet varieties are Peal millet hybrid COH10, Sorghum K13, Kudiraivali ATL1 and Panivaragu ATL2.


The Vice Chancellor of TNAU Geethalakshimi, on Wednesday, February 15 said that 23 new crop varieties including 16 crops, four tree varieties and three horticulture crops have been introduced other than the four varieties of millets. The horticultural crops include two types of Ridge Gourd and a variety of Jasmine stated a report by IANS.

The institution has also created new tree kinds for the state government's afforestation effort. These include khaya trees, red sanders, casuarinas, silk cotton, and red sanders, all of which farmers may purchase from the agricultural university. According to the Vice Chancellor, without sacrificing quality or nutritional content, farm yields must rise to keep up with the nation's growing population. The loss of crops that were ready to be harvested due to exceptional rainfall in the delta area, she added, is evidence that the shifting weather patterns are posing a danger to farming and agriculture as reported by IANS.

On India's proposal, the United Nations declared 2023 as the International Year of Millets.

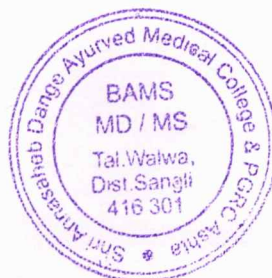

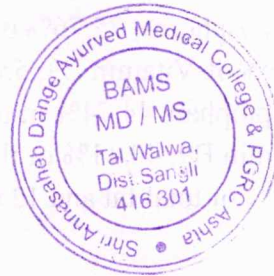

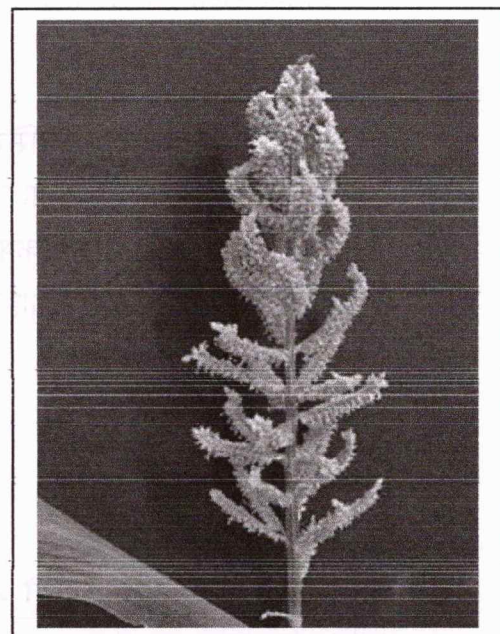

**Morphology** - Echinochloa frumentacea is a ANNUAL growing to 1.8 m (6ft) by 0.2 m (0ft 8in). It is in flower from July to September, and the seeds ripen from September to October. The species is hermaphrodite (has both male and female organs) and is pollinated by Wind. Suitable for: light (sandy), medium (loamy) and heavy (clay) soils and prefers well-drained soil. Suitable pH: mildly acid, neutral and basic (mildly alkaline) soils. It cannot grow in the shade. It prefers moist soil. The plant can tolerate strong winds but not maritime exposure.

**Useful Part** - Seeds

**Cultivation** - Japanese millet is sometimes cultivated in India and E. Asia for its edible seed, especially in areas where rice will not grow. There are some named varieties. Plants can produce a crop of seeds within 6 weeks of sowing in warmer areas of the world but obtaining a reasonable crop is more problematic in the cooler summers of Britain. They are also more likely to succeed in the eastern side of the country where the summers are usually warmer and drier.

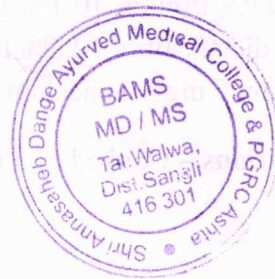

**Morphology -** Job's tear is a monoecious grass which is broad-leaved, loose-growing, branched and robust. It can reach a height between 1.20 m to 1.80 m. Like all members of the genus Grasses, their inflorescences develop from a leaf sheath at the End of the stem and consist partly of hard, globular or oval, hollow, bead-like structures. Job's tear seeds differ in color, with the more soft-shelled seeds being light brown and the hard-shelled forms having a dark red pericarp.

The hardened "shells" covering the seeds are technically the fruit-case or involucre (hardened bract), with the bract also referred to as "capsule-spathe" or "sheathing bract" by some past botanical works.

These shells cover the bases of the flowers (inflorescences) which are male and female racemes/panicles; the male racemes project upright and consist of overlapping scale-like spikelets, with yellow stamens that pop out in-between, and there are one or two yarn-like female racemes drooping from the base



**Cultivation -** Coix lacryma-job grows best in the moister areas of the tropics, succeeding at elevations up to 2,000 metres. It is reported to tolerate an annual precipitation in the range of 610 - 4290mm and an average annual temperature range from 9.6 to 27.8°C. Plants are not very tolerant of frost, though one report that needs verifying says that some forms of the plant are said to be very cold tolerant, with reports of plants surviving occasional lows to -35°C

**Useful Part** - Grains

**Cultivation** - coracana (Finger millet or Eleusine) is **widely cultivated in Africa and India**, commonly known as 'ragi' found to be originated in the beginning of Iron Age about 5000 years ago in the highlands of Eastern Africa (from western Uganda to Ethiopia) by domestication of wild weedy forms and termed as oldest known ...


**Chemical Constituents** - It is rich in **calcium (0.34%), dietary fiber (18%), phytates (0.48%), protein (6%–13%) minerals (2.5%–3.5%), and phenolics (0.3%–3%)**. Moreover, it is also a rich source of thiamine, riboflavin, iron, methionine, isoleucine, leucine, phenylalanine and other essential amino acids.

**Nutritional value** - Finger millet contains about **5–8% protein, 1–2% ether extractives, 65–75% carbohydrates, 15–20% dietary fiber and 2.5–3.5% minerals** (Chethan and Malleshi 2007a). It has the highest calcium content among all cereals (344 mg/100 g).

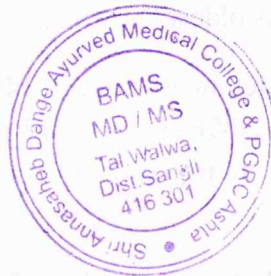

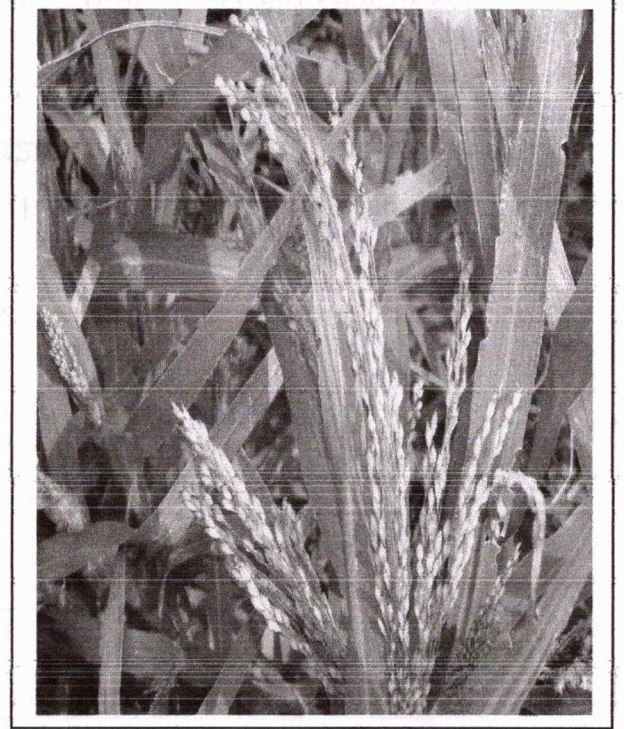

The grain is round and smooth, 1.8 to 1.9 mm (0.071 to 0.075 in) long.

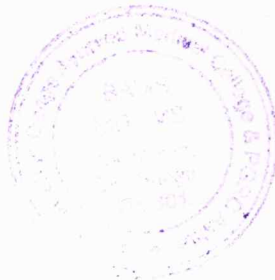
### Useful Part - Seeds


**Cultivation** - A plant of the tropics and subtropics, where it can be found at elevations up to 2,100 metres. It grows best in areas where annual daytime temperatures are within the range 22 - 27°C, but can tolerate 15 - 45°C. It prefers a mean annual rainfall in the range 350 - 500mm, but tolerates 150 - 1,200mm. Requires a sunny position. Succeeds in most soils, preferring one that is well-drained. The plant is tolerant of both drought and water logging. Prefers a pH in the range 5.5 - 6.2, tolerating 5 - 7. Plants can produce a crop even on very poor soils. They are usually sown together with a major cereal. The plant can mature a crop in 75 - 150 days from sowing the seed. Yields are usually between 225 - 560 kg/ha, but in a good season yields may be up to 900 kg/ha.

**Chemical Constituents** – Hydroxybenzoic acid and Hydroxycinnamic Acids, Myricetin, Catechin, Luteolin, Apigenin, Daidzein, Naringenin, Kaempferol, And Quercetin

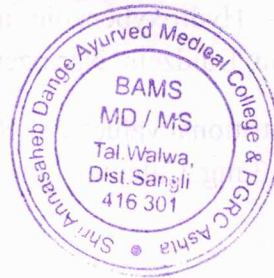
