

- b) For Candidates belonging to Scheduled Tribe the Tribe Validity Certificate is issued by Director/Deputy Director, Tribe Certificate Scrutiny Committee of respective Region (Konkan, Pune, Nashik, Aurangabad, Amravati and Nagpur).
- 5) The candidate should have claimed the constitutional reservation in the original application form. The candidate claiming constitutional reservation must submit original caste validity certificate at the time of counseling for document verification, failing which the category claim will not be granted.

#### 6) NON-CREAMY LAYER

A candidate belonging to 'Creamy Layer' amongst the categories (C) to (G) must note that the provision of reservation is NOT applicable to him/her. A candidate claiming benefit of reservation under the categories (C) to (G) above will be required to produce Non-Creamy layer certificate as specified in the Government resolution CBC-10/2008/CR-697 VJNT-1, dated 24th June, 2013. The certificate should be valid upto 31/03/2023. The Non-Creamy Layer Certificate is issued by Sub-Divisional Officer/Deputy Collector/Collector of the district.

However, such a Non-Creamy Layer Certificate shall be produced in any case at the time of filling up of Preference Form, failing which the category claimed will not be granted.



- 5) Those candidates who has got allotment other than their first priority and willing to upgrade for better priority shall have to report and join allotted Research Centre as per their allotment letter in First Round and shall communicate his/her non-retention (Annexure-B) of the allotted seat to the allotted Research centre. In such case, he/she need not to submit their documents and fees to their Research centre.
- 6) It is mandatory for in-Service candidates to produce the No Objection Certificate in prescribed format from their employer within six months from the date of admission.
- 7) For reserved category candidates, they have to produce all required documents i.e. Caste Certificate, Caste Validity Certificate, Non-Creamy Layer Certificate, Economically Weaker Section Certificate, Disability Certificate as applicable to their allotted research centre. Kindly note that the allotment of candidates to the Ph.D. Guides should be as per the clause 9 (5) of the University Direction No. 01/2020.
- 10) After retention / non-retention by the candidate, the concerned Dean / Principal / Director of all affiliated Research Centre are requested to submit the vacancy position to the University on or before 20/12/2022 in Annexure-D by e-mail on udc@muhs.ac.in



11) The concerned Dean / Principal / Director of all affiliated Research Centre are requested to submit the Retention form (Annexure-A), Provisional Registration form (Annexure-C) and one set of self-attested photocopies of all the documents of the concerned candidates to the University at the earliest. Further, it will be communicated separately by the University, for submission of relevant original documents of all admitted candidates to the University for grant of Eligibility purpose. Kindly note and do the needful.
