

2.5.4 POLICY DOCUMENT OF MIDCOURSE IMPROVEMENT OF PERFORMANCE OF STUDENTS

Midcourse improvement helps students by continuous monitoring of the student's performance by the faculty and providing feedback for improvement in weak areas of performance to encourage them achieve excellence by giving opportunities. Curriculum includes internal assessment exams, remedial teaching and periodicals. The purpose of this policy document is to create a nurturing environment, enable students to imbibe values, prepare students to confidently appear for their exams. Faculty conducts surprise-test. Project-based assignments, home assignments. Remedial exams to evaluate student's present performance to get better results and also conduct extra classes for Slow learner students. The internal assessment exam time table schedules are conducted as per the university norms and communicated to the students well in advance. The scheduled date of internal examination and syllabus are displayed on the respective department notice boards. According to new curriculum reforms first and second year BAMS have two term end internal exam and nine Periodicals. For third- and fourth-year BAMS two term end internal examination and betterment.

The internal marks are given after assessing student's performance in internal marks theory and practical exams Those students who have scored below eligibility level are encouraged to appear for betterment exam to enhance their examination score. After examination, the results are prepared within the stipulated time and conveyed to the students in the classroom and displayed on the department notice board within one week. Corrected answer papers of the students are distributed in the classroom for verification and grievance redressal immediately Students are further guided for their better performance in subsequent examinations. Any student who is not satisfied with the assessment, and given marks may approach to the concerned HOD/In-charge. Parents are informed about their ward's performance. Parent teacher meetings are conducted and remedial measures are taken. For slow learners, special attention is given during academic year and their progress is evaluated.





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This ensures minimal stress on students while preparing for assessment tests and the complete procedure is maintained by transparent and unbiased means.

Opportunities Provided to Students for Midcourse Improvements:

Sr. No.	Particulars	Details
1	Timely administration of CIE	The college prepares the Internal examination schedule well in advance and informs the students about the schedules at the beginning of the academic year through the academic calendar. This enables the students to be aware of examination dates and prepare for the examination.
2	On time assessment & feedback	The academic council committee supervises the entire and examination & evaluation process. Answer sheets are evaluated by the respective faculty and results are conveyed to students within 7 working days. Feedback for improvement of students' performances is also conveyed in the further examinations during distribution of papers.
3	Makeup assignments/ tests	Repeater students and slow learners are made to write make up assignments on the examination papers to enable them knowing the subject.
4	Remedial teaching / support	Remedial measures included with one-to-one teaching for slow learners. Complete revision of portions done with Extra Classes and group discussions. Training students for examination with previous year question banks. Counselling is given to students for better performances in further examinations.



These regulations have been developed in accordance with the norms given by, NCISM and Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik.

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

CIE policy of UG students as per NCISM Gazette no. CG-DL-E-17022022-233547 dated on 16 feb 2022 Implementation since academic year 2022-23 is


a) The First Professional-

- a. Examination shall ordinarily be held and completed by the end of First professional session
- b. the student who failed in one or two subjects of First Professional shall be allowed to keep terms of the Second Professional session and to appear in Second Professional examination;
- c. The student who failed in more than two subjects shall not be allowed to keep term in Second Professional session and the subsequent supplementary examination of First Professional shall be held at every six months.

b) The Second Professional

- d. examination shall ordinarily be held and completed by the end of Second Professional session:
- e. the student who failed in one or two subjects of Second Professional shall be allowed to keep the term of the Third (Final) Professional session:
- f. The student who failed in more than two subjects shall not be allowed to keep term in Third (Final) Professional session and the subsequent supplementary examinations of Second Professional shall be held every six months.

c) The Third (Final) Professional





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- g. Examination shall ordinarily be held and completed by the end of Third (Final) Professional session.
- h. Before appearing for Third (Final) Professional examination the students shall have to pass all the subjects of first and second professional and shall qualify nine electives.
- i. The subsequent supplementary examination of Third (Final) professional will be held at every six months.
- j. There shall be no separate class for odd batch student (those students who could not keep the term) and the student has to attend the class along with regular batch or with junior batch as applicable.





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ASSESSMENT-

Assessment of students shall be in the form of Formative and Summative Assessments as under-

Formative Assessment.- Students shall be assessed periodically to assess their performance in the class, determine the understanding of programme material and their learning outcome in the following manner, namely:-Periodical Assessment shall be carried out at the end of teaching of a topic or module or a particular portion of syllabus and the evaluation methods as per the following table may be adopted as suits to the content, namely:

(Evaluation methods for periodical assessment)

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2.5.4 Report of CIE and remedial teaching:

- Every batch faces Internal Assessment Examinations (CIE) twice in a year, I and II
 Term End Internals, at the end of their first and second terms, respectively, as schemed by the MUHS.
- Only theory exams are conducted at the end of I terms, whereas both, theory and practical exams are conducted at the end of II terms.
- Each one is expected to score minimum 50% marks in each subject for passing the

 - 1. In January and April for regular batches starting in August.
 - 2. In July and October for odd batches starting in February.
