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Emergency kit and mock drill for the management of complications of Kriyakalpa:

Kriyakalpa is very soothing eye treatment having very few side effects noted during the procedure. Though if any complications such as heena, mithya and atiyoga found then following measures are taken:

1. In case of heena yoga - again the same procedure is followed with concise and precise precautions. Appropriate dose of the dravya is decided and the procedure is repeated making the patient comfortable.
2. In case of atiyoga-
 - a. Immediately the procedure of Kriyakalp is stopped.
 - b. Eyes are rinsed with sterile water, cleaned followed by Pittashamak chikitsa.
 - c. If burning sensation occurs, Paracaine eye drops or Ocurest eye drops are used.
 - d. In case of dryness of eyes, Carboxy methyl cellulose eye drops eg. Lubrex eye drops are used.
 - e. In case of any other infection, Triphala kwath is used for Netra dhawan.
 - f. Rest is advised depending upon the severity.
3. Symptomatic treatment is given accordingly in Casualty Unit of Dhanwantari Hospital.
4. Patient is kept under observation and monitored time to time.
5. Patient is also monitored for allergic reactions.
6. Emergency medicines are kept ready and monitoring is done for pulse, Blood pressure and respiration etc.
7. In case of severe infection, Antibody coverage is given.



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
